Consensus of the Council was to fund an Animal Control Program and funding part-time employees in the Sanitation Department to assist in the bulk item and grass/brush pick up each week. Council and staff discussed using community service workers and work force development workers to keep paid staff levels as low as possible.</i></p>

Resolution in Support of Mayodan Mountain Bike Trail

WHEREAS the Town of Mayodan seeks funding from the Recreational Trail Program in the amount of approximately \$36,000 to lengthen the current trail to a total of 4.5 miles;

WHEREAS recreational trails benefit local citizens by providing opportunities for exercise and fostering economic development;

WHEREAS the Town of Mayodan is committed to maintain said trail;

WHEREAS said trail is legally permissible per Mayodan Town Council and will not violate any environmental regulations;

WHEREAS said trail shall be constructed following International Mountain Biking Association best management practices;

WHEREAS said trail is the sole public mountain bike trail in western Rockingham County, is the "home" trail of the McMichael Mountain Bike Club, and is used by local walkers and cyclists;

WHEREAS the West Rock Rivers & Trails Group, the local trail advocacy citizen group, has expressed desire to lengthen said trail;

WHEREAS the Town of Mayodan has previously adopted the Pathways Plan for Recreational Trails and includes what is now known at the Mayodan Mountain Bike Trail;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Mayodan supports further development of the Mayodan Mountain Bike Trail at Farris Memorial Park
