ADVISORY BULLETINS



- ✓ Scrape excess grease in a container and dispose of it in the garbage.
- ✓ Place food scraps in waste containers or garbage bags for disposal with solid wastes, or start a compost pile; promote use of scraping ware prior to washing.
- ✓ Place a wastebasket in the bathroom to dispose of solid wastes. Disposable diapers, condoms, and personal hygiene products do not belong in the sewer system.
- ✓ Promote the concept of "3 R's": Reduce, Reuse, Recycle.

DO NOT

- ✗ Pour grease, fats, and oils from cooking down the drain.
- ✗ Use the toilet as a wastebasket.
- ✗ Use the sewer as a means of disposing food scraps.

Don't Feed the Grease Goblin!

DO	DO NOT
✓ Put oil and grease in collection containers	✗ Pour oil and grease down drains
✓ Remove oil and grease from kitchen utensils, equipment, and food preparation areas with scrapers/towels/brooms	✗ Wash fryers/griddles, pots/pans, and plates with water until oil and grease are removed
✓ Keep grease out of wash water	✗ Use hot water to rinse grease off surfaces
✓ Place food scraps in collection containers	✗ Put food scraps down drains
