

# TOWN OF MAYODAN

## Solid Waste Services Guide



### General Information

*The Town of Mayodan provides over 1,100 residents and property owners the following solid waste services for a monthly fee.*

- **WEEKLY** residential waste pick-up
- **TWICE-WEEKLY** commercial waste pick-up (no dumpsters)
- **BI-WEEKLY** recycling pick-up
- **BULK** item waste pick-up
- **WEEKLY** bagged grass pick-up
- **WEEKLY** bulk yard waste pick-up
- **LOOSE** leaf pick-up (November — January) and bagged leaf pick-up at all other times of the year.

## FEES AND SCHEDULE OF SERVICES

**RESIDENTIAL:** \$12 PER MONTH  
EXTRA CART: \$10 PER MONTH, LIMIT 3 TOTAL  
**COMMERCIAL:** \$24 PER MONTH  
EXTRA CART \$20 PER MONTH  
BILLED ON BI-MONTHLY UTILITY SERVICES BILL  
**A FEE WILL BE ASSESSED FOR ADDITIONAL BULK ITEMS OR YARD DEBRIS LARGER THAN 7 CUBIC FEET IN SIZE TO BE DETERMINED BY THE PUBLIC UTILITIES DIRECTOR**

### SCHEDULE

- **RESIDENTIAL** pick-up is Tuesday
- **COMMERCIAL** pick-up is Tuesday and Friday
- **BULK ITEM, YARD WASTE/BRUSH & BAGGED GRASS/ LEAF** pick-up is generally Monday

**HOLIDAYS & ADVERSE WEATHER** often result in changes in collection days. Generally collections will be delayed one day. For an up-to-date schedule visit our website [townofmayodan.com](http://townofmayodan.com).

### PROPER CART PLACEMENT AND CARE

- All household solid waste must be placed in the Town-provided, roll-out carts by 6:00 AM on the day of pick-up.
- Roll-out carts are the property of the Town and should be left at the residence if you move. If the cart is damaged or the lid is broken please call 336-427-0241 to request a repair.
- Place carts away from vehicles, mail boxes, or other obstructions, including overhead utility lines and trees; carts should be accessible to sanitation equipment.
- To prevent garbage from spilling into the street, garbage should be bagged; containers should not be overflowing; and lids should be able to close.
- Recycling waste should be loose—no bags, per request of the recycling services company.
- **NO BAGS OR OTHER HOUSEHOLD TRASH WILL BE PICKED UP THAT IS PLACED OUTSIDE THE CART.**

## RECYCLING

THE State of North Carolina has banned the following materials from solid waste landfills:

**Aluminum cans, plastic bottles, lead-acid batteries, electronic equipment, yard waste, wooden pallets, and white goods.**



Mayodan provides bi-weekly curbside recycling pick-up. NOTE: We no longer accept recycling or other materials at the Public Utilities facility.

You may place the following materials in the recycling carts:

- Plastic Bottles—Only bottles with a neck or opening smaller than the widest part of bottle
- Aluminum and Steel food or beverage cans
- Junk Mail and office paper, magazines and catalogs (no books)
- Corrugated cardboard (no used pizza boxes)
- Glass food and beverage containers
- Empty aerosol cans w/o caps
- Newspapers and inserts
- Cardboard milk and juice cartons

The Town will pick-up bulky items that are recyclable— TVs, Electronics, White Goods— as part of bulk item pick-up.

## BULK ITEMS

We encourage you to consider recycling furniture, white goods, TVs, clothing, household and kitchen appliances, and electronic devices before placing them in the trash. There are a number of local non-profits and church-based groups that will accept donations.

Bulk Items are defined as large or odd sized items that cannot fit into a rollout container and are acceptable for recycling or disposal in a landfill including furniture, appliances, white goods, and other refuse allowed by the Town. **This does not include extra garbage bags or other waste that does not fit due to an overloaded cart.**

Residential properties will be allowed seven cubic yards of bulk items per week free of charge (See graphic, below). Any single item weighing more than 200 lbs. will not be collected without additional charge for service. The town reserves the right to reject collection or charge an additional fee for collection of bulk waste items or piles larger than permitted by the Town Solid Waste Ordinance.



**When work that generates bulk waste is performed by, or contracted to, construction contractors, builders, or other commercial workers, the contracting party is responsible for the removal and disposal of all waste.**

Any property owner or resident who cannot place bulk items at the curb shall either personally dispose of bulk items, call the Town to arrange for a special pick-up, or arrange for a truck to be delivered. This service is subject to availability and is not guaranteed. Special collections will be charged a fee.

## YARD WASTE

**-Never place yard waste in your garbage cart. It is illegal to dispose of yard waste in a NC landfill. Roll-out carts with yard waste will not be emptied.**

GRASS CLIPPINGS and soft plant materials should be placed in clear plastic bags and placed at the curb or street edge.

LOOSE LEAF COLLECTION takes place between November 1<sup>st</sup> and January 31<sup>st</sup>. The Town will make three full passes through Town to collect leaves placed at the curb or street edge. **DO NOT** place any other materials (branches, garbage, bulk items, dirt, rock, etc.) in the piles with the leaves. The timing and specific routes will be posted at Town Hall and on the Town website.

BAGGED LEAVES will be picked-up during other times of the year. Bags should not weigh more than 50 lbs and should be placed at the curb or street edge.

## BULK YARD WASTE

BULK YARD WASTE includes tree limbs, small trees, and brush. Waste should be placed at the curb or street edge either bundled, stacked neatly, placed in plastic bags, or in a container no larger than 32 gallons.

Tree limbs should not exceed 10" in diameter, shall be cut into lengths no longer than 5', nor weigh more than 200 lbs. Residential properties will be allowed 7 cubic yards of bulk yard waste per week (See graphic). **Commercial tree services or similar contractors are responsible for the removal and disposal of bulk yard waste that they generate.**
