The Mayodan Town Council met at 9:00 a.m., February 21, 2018, in the council room of the James A. Collins Municipal Building, and with a quorum present Mayor Pro Tem Darrell Allred called the meeting to order.

Business:	<p><i>Mayor Pro Tem Allred asked Council to consider a Resolution to Surplus and Award Police Officer Jackie Lemons her service handgun and badge.</i></p> <p>Motion by Councilman Holland, seconded by Councilman Wall, to approve the resolution to surplus and award Police Officer Jackie Lemons the service handgun and badge assigned to her as an employee. <i>Ayes: Councilmen Allred, Bottoms, Cardwell, Holland, and Wall</i> <i>Nays: None</i> <i>Motion carried unanimously.</i></p> <p><i>Mayor Bullins arrived at 9:20 a.m.</i></p> <p><i>Council conducted discussions regarding the 2018-2019 fiscal year.</i> <i>Town Manager Michael Brandt went over 2017-2018 project statuses and revenues.</i></p> <p><i>*Small Town Main Street – The Town is barely meeting the guidelines and Council will be deciding whether to stay in the program or not. The annual dues are \$350 for Small Town Main Street, and \$200 in dues to the N.C. Downtown Association. The program requires a dedication of 10 hours a week and reporting requirements.</i></p> <p><i>Chief Caruso, Joey Hudy, Mike Sears, Quint Haley and Lee Mitchell each participated in discussions regarding department project statuses and broad expectations for the upcoming budget.</i></p> <p><i>Councilman David Holland asked to be excused at 3:30 p.m. Council consensus was to excuse Councilman Holland from the remainder of the meeting.</i></p> <p><i>Council discussed the proposed solid waste collection/recycling collection renewal contract with Foothill Waste Services, Inc. Council felt a three-year contract would be more appropriate than a five-year contract, and a 3% increase followed with the capability of the servicer to increase the cost by 1.5% in each of the second and third year.</i></p>
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	<p><i>Council continued discussions regarding revenues for 2018-2019 and projected budget issues for 2017-2018 budget.</i></p> <p>Motion by Councilman Cardwell, seconded by Councilman Allred, to adjourn the meeting. <i>Ayes: Allred, Bottoms, Cardwell, and Wall.</i> <i>Nays: None.</i> <i>Motion carried unanimously.</i></p> <p><i>Council adjourned at 5:13 p.m.</i></p>
