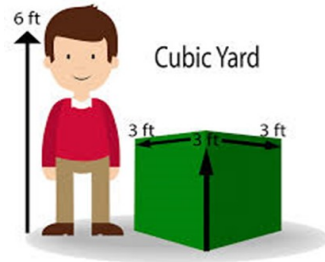
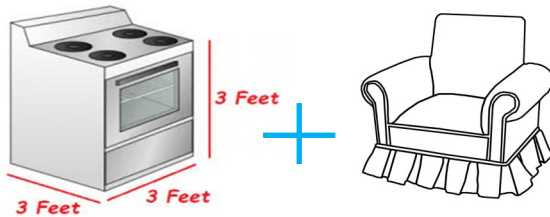


## What is a cubic yard?



A cubic yard measures 3 feet wide x 3 feet tall x 3 feet deep. This is roughly the same size as a standard kitchen stove, a washer, or a chair.

**You may dispose of two cubic yards of bulk waste every other week for no additional fee.**



Classifications of waste material are explained inside of this brochure. Please keep it for future reference.

### Annual loose leaf collection November 1 to February 1

- ⇒ Keep leaf piles free of all other items, such as grass clippings, sticks, rocks, and dirt. Mixed piles will not be collected.
- ⇒ Never put leaves in the street where they create safety hazards and clog storm drains.
- ⇒ Outside of the designated collection period, leaves must be placed on the curb in bags not to exceed 50 pounds each.

### REMINDERS:

Yard waste is picked up each **MONDAY**. Most items should be placed in clear plastic bags. (See Yard Waste section for details.)

Please sort **recycling items** carefully! Placing prohibited items in your recycle container may cause an entire truck load to be rejected by recycling facilities. **NO PLASTIC BAGS!**

Cans should be placed at the curb on the evening prior to pickup. Lids should be closed.

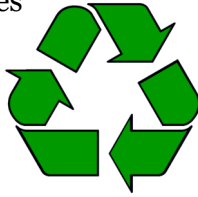

## Recycle Waste Collection

("A" Day - Every other Wednesday)

The Town of Mayodan provides residential curbside recycling pickup. Do not place recycle items in bags - all items must be placed directly inside the recycle cart provided to you.



### Acceptable recycling items include:

- ✓ Plastic bottles - only bottles with a neck or opening smaller than the widest part of the bottle.
- ✓ Aluminum or steel food and beverage cans
- ✓ Glass food and beverage containers
- ✓ Junk mail and office paper, magazines, and catalogs. **No books.**
- ✓ Newspapers and inserts
- ✓ Corrugated cardboard boxes and cereal boxes, flattened. **No pizza boxes.**
- ✓ Empty aerosol cans without caps

All containers must be rinsed with no food or food residue remaining.

### Items you may NOT place in the recycle cart:

- × No pizza boxes
- × No cardboard milk and juice cartons
- × No styrofoam items, including carry out food containers and packaging matter
- × No plastic bags (trash or shopping bags) or similar materials
- × No clothing or similar items
- × No food, household waste, yard waste, buckets, toys, wood, holiday decorations, or items other than those listed above

Recycle carts containing prohibited items will not be emptied. Residents will need to remove all non-recyclable items before the cart is emptied on the next pick up date.

## Bulk Waste Collection

("A" Day - Every other Wednesday)

Bulk waste items are defined as large or odd-sized items that will not fit into your rollout garbage container.

### Acceptable bulk waste items include:

- ✓ Appliances (stove, washer, refrigerator, water heater, dryer, microwave, etc.)
- ✓ Furniture (couch, chair, bed, dresser, mattress, table, desk, etc.)
- ✓ Swing set if disassembled
- ✓ Door
- ✓ Toilet
- ✓ Television

### Bulk waste items the Town does not pick up include:

- × No hazardous waste, chemicals, or paint
- × No construction or remodeling debris
- × No concrete or brick
- × No rocks, dirt, or sand
- × No tree stumps
- × No logs
- × No medical waste
- × No fuel oils
- × No batteries
- × No tires
- × No computers
- × No general household waste or clothing items that will fit into the rollout garbage container



**Bulk waste fees:** Two cubic yards of bulk waste per billing account per pickup date will be accepted at no additional fee. For loads exceeding 2 cubic yards, customers must pay \$10 per additional cubic yard prior to the Town picking up the excess waste.

## Yard Waste

North Carolina law prohibits the disposal of yard waste in a landfill. Never place yard waste in your regular garbage container.

**Ordinary yard waste** is the result of routine mowing and maintenance of the property. This includes grass clippings, sticks, leaves, flowers, trimmings, vegetable and garden material. These items must be placed in clear plastic bags and placed at the curb or street edge. Pickup is weekly on Mondays with no additional fee.

**Bulk yard waste collection** is provided every other Wednesday to eliminate larger sticks, branches, and debris from pruning shrubbery or small landscaping projects. Items must be stacked at the curb or street edge and bundled if possible.

### Acceptable bulk yard waste includes:

- ✓ Tree limbs - must be cut to 5 feet or less in length and be less than 6 inches in diameter
- ✓ Sticks
- ✓ Brush

**"B" Day Pickup  
Every other Wednesday**

### Bulk yard waste items the Town does not pick up include:

- × No logs or stumps
- × No limbs exceeding specified sizes

The Town does not pick up debris from contracted landscaping or tree service.

**Bulk yard waste fees:** Seven cubic yards of bulk yard waste per billing account per pickup date will be accepted at no additional fee. Loads exceeding 7 cubic yards are charged \$10 per additional cubic yard with charges calculated by Town staff and payment due prior to pickup.
